#### Asset - Possible argument/conversation Ideation

## Ideas for potential Conversations.

- 1. Renee is reading a fairytale to a young Elliot, Bordeaux walks in after hearing the two of them laughing about something. He bursts in, arguing about Elliot being too old for silly stories/girly nonsense. Renee fights back a little calmly, almost jokingly, but Bordeaux keeps escalating the argument, leaving Bordeaux to confiscate the book.
- 2. During a family and friends gathering, Bordeaux starts a toast for his wife; however, during the speech, she leaves to attend to a crying Elliot (Spilled something on himself, possibly or is having a fuss about something). Bordeaux excuses himself from the gathering, and he follows after Reene to scold her for leaving during a toast for her.
- 3. Bordeaux comes home after an argument about wine labels at work. Renee tries to offer some advice, but Bordeaux keeps dismissing her, "What would you know about wine?" (Note: not in an angry, intentionally demeaning way but in a style that is more shocked and humorous)
- 4. Renee is very pregnant at this point with child number 2; she argues with Bordeaux about wanting to go somewhere by herself or with him on a trip, but Bordeaux is concerned for her health as of late. She argues with him for some independence. The only way this conversation is broken up is thanks to a young Elliot (falling off his bike, calling home from boarding school, coming home with good news of some sort).
- 5. Renee is comforting Elliot after a fight with some kids at school. Bordeaux wants to have a fierce word not only with the parents of the children but with the school as well, and is making preparations to toughen up Elliot. Renee is hesitant to want to do anything and considers having him closer to home and that last time something like this happened the school didn't do anything.
